'Activities' Volunteer

This role involves supporting the project workers when organising and delivering 'activities'. These activities will be informal and fun and will either be arranged for the children or for the whole family. The purpose of these activities is to form a professional relationship with the women and their children in order to encourage them to engage with our services. Throughout the summer period we will be holding 'fun' type days out.

Activities will be varied and you will be expected to observe high standards of safety at all times.

You will also be expected to carry out other tasks within the role as requested by the refuge staff.

You will be required to complete an application form and attend an informal interview; if successful we will take up two references and also a CRB check.

Some experience of working with children would be preferable but is not essential.

You will be notified of any available and relevant training opportunities.

You can expect to claim reasonable travel expenses.
